The Position

The Centura Public School District Board of Education, Boelus, Cairo and Dannebrog, Nebraska, is seeking a highly qualified and fully certified **Superintendent**. The Board wishes to have the successful candidate assume the responsibilities of the position July 1, 2018.

The Communities

The Centura Public School District is made up of the communities of Boelus (population 189), Cairo (population 804), and Dannebrog (population 302) and is located in Central Nebraska. The district borders 10 miles of Grand Island (over 48,000 population).

Major employers in the area are located in Grand Island. Boelus includes a bank, grocery store and catering business, Cairo includes two banks, coffee shop, Senior Center, golf course, bowling alley, and church daycare/preschool. Dannebrog includes a bank and grocery store. All three communities have their own volunteer fire department, city parks, and gas stations.

The communities have the following churches:

Cairo- Baptist, Mennonite, Methodist, Missouri Synod Lutheran

Boelus – Methodist

Dannebrog – Baptist, ELCA Lutheran

Annual celebrations in the area include the Cairo Cornstalk Festival, Dannebrog Danish Christmas, and Dannebrog Grundlovsfest.

Higher educational opportunities area available from Central Community College and Doane College (satellite site) in Grand Island, the University of Nebraska-Kearney, Central Community College and Hastings College in Hastings.

The Centura Public School District has an enrollment of 486 students (PK-12) and covers 220 square miles. Ninety employees consist of three administrators, 48 certificated staff, and 39 classified staff. The district is accredited by the North Central Association.

Centura enjoys a strong academic reputation. Special programs available to students include HAL (High Ability Learners) in the elementary and high school, Junior High and High School Academic Quiz Bowl, and Junior High and High School Science Olympiad.

The school district has partnerships with Central Community College for distance learning and on-line courses, as well as a college chemistry class through Hastings College.

Extracurricular activities available to students include football, basketball, volleyball, softball, cross country, wrestling, track, baseball, and trapshooting. Non-sport activities include one-act, band, summer band, vocal music, speech, Student Council, FBLA, FFA, NHS, yearbook, cheerleading, and dance.

New this year for Centura High School is Discovery Days – a two day session of students exploring career choices and new hobbies as seen by pictures in this brochure.

Over the past 12 years, Centura high school students have enjoyed the opportunity to use their own laptop computers for coursework, making this the fourth round of laptop computers purchased. Elementary students have then had the opportunity of participating with used laptops for their coursework. iPads are also used widely in the elementary by students.

The Centura Educational Foundation is one of the largest in the state - \$1.2 million providing college on-line scholarships, scholarships for graduating seniors, and teacher grants.

The assessed valuation of the school district is \$599,323,750, with an operating budget of \$8,552.000. Our tax rate is \$0.932913 for the general fund and \$0.049378 for the Special Building Fund.

Centura Public School facilities are in good condition and the district has no bond indebtedness. This summer the high school science rooms will undergo a much needed renovation.

The Board of Education

The Board of Education consists of six members who are elected to serve a four-year term. The tenure of the Board members ranges from two to six years.

- A completed application form
- Reference letters, certificates and licenses, and academic transcripts from colleges/universities indicating degree(s)
